

Wine Gift Tote

Description: The Wine Gift Tote would make a great housewarming, hostess, or holiday gift. Make one for yourself too. If it's anything like at our house, we are often grabbing a bottle of wine to take with to a party. It's so classy to arrive with your wine in a wine tote! Make the tote with one layer out of insulated batting. That way if you're going to barbeque or a cheese and wine picnic on a warm day, the tote would help to keep white wine cool.

Finished Size: 13" high x 8" wide x 2 ½" deep

Skill Level: Beginner to all levels

Fabric Requirements:

Fat Quarter Main Fabric (for the body of the wine tote)
½ yard Accent/Lining Fabric (lining, base& handles)

½ yard of Pellon 987 Fusible Fleece½ yard of Pellon Shape Flex 101

Other Materials:

Thread to match

Skill Level: Beginner to all levels

Supplies Needed for Evening of Class:

- Sewing machine with coordinating thread, appropriate needle, machine feet
- Rotary cutter
- Straight Pins
- Pencil
- Frixion pen or water soluble marker
- Seam Ripper (just in case)

HOMEWORK....There is a small amount of cutting & fusing for this project. 1. Cut Out Your Fabric (measurements are given in height x width)

From Main Fabric/Exterior (FQ#1):

(1) 16" x 17" body of wine tote

From Accent/Lining:

(1) 16" x 17" body of the wine tote

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- (1) 5" x 17" base
- (2) 4" x 12" handles

Cut from Fusible Fleece: (1) 16" x 17" and (2) 2" x 11"

Cut from SF101: (1) 16" x 17"

2. Apply Interfacing

Fuse the fusible fleece to the wrong side of the 16" x 17" main fabric. Center & fuse the 2" x 11" fusible fleece to the WS of each handle piece.

Fuse the SF101 to the wrong side of the 16" x 17" lining.

This is a great project for the beginner as well as the experienced sewist!!
