Description: This fun and modern quilt pattern plays with the popular star shape. The Expanding Stars large scale quilt goes together quickly with half square triangles. No tricky piecing makes this one great for a beginner.

Choose your favorite fabrics and show them off with this stunner!! Instructions included to make a baby size, throw size, large throw size, queen size and king size quilt. Fabric requirements listed in photos.

This super fun quilt is great for the confident beginners as well as the more experienced quilter. Make is modern, traditional or scrappy...make it **YOURS!!!**

Skill Level: Beginner

This pattern requires beginner quilting knowledge. The pattern assumes quilter has knowledge of basic piecing and can use consistent 1/4" seam allowances.

Class Time: 9:30am - 3:30pm

Materials Needed (as written on the pattern)

Supplies Needed for Day of Class:

- Sewing machine with appropriate thread
- Size 12 or 14 needle
- Pins, rotary cutter, rulers (6 ½ x 12 is a useful size),
- Cutting mat for personal use
- Pencil, chalk, water soluble pen or frixion pen to mark with
- 12 ½" square ruler with a diagonal line to trim half square triangles...used for all sizes
- 6 ½" Bloc_loc Ruler (optional but helpful for trimming half square triangles HST up to the queen size quilt) ** other specialty rulers assist in trimming HST

- How to make 8 half square triangle blocks using a one specific method
- How to use a ruler to trim HST blocks
- How to layout the blocks given a diagram
- How to read and understand patterns directions
- Reinforce your vocabulary of ¼" seam allowance verses scant ¼"
- Additional tips and techniques

HOMEWORK..... Read through the directions on the pattern to familiarize yourself with the information. Please cut all your fabrics (A through F) in advance except the binding. If you would like a planning page (add fabric swatches & coloring page), please contact me at the email address below.

Make sure you have all your fabrics & supplies for class.

We will begin with Making Half Square Triangles (HST).
