Supplies You'll Need:

- French Rose pattern
- Fabric purchased at Gigis Fabric Shop
- Batting
- Sheet of Template plastic
- Straight pins
- Temporary Fabric Marker
- Scissors or rotary cutter for fabric cutting
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Ruler (6" x 12" or larger)

What's Provided in Class:

- White thread
- White bobbin thread
- Sewing needle

French Rose Quilt Class

Fabric Requirements – Pillow Version:

- 6 or more coordinated fat quarters
- (2/3 yard) background fabric – cut into one 24" square
- (1 1/3 yards) muslin – cut into two 24" squares
- (crib size) batting or fusible fleece – cut into two 24" squares

Please Cut Before Class:

For Pillow Version:

- 6 or more coordinated fat quarters
- (1) 24" square background fabric
- (2) 24" squares muslin
- (2) 24" squares batting or fusible fleece

For Quilt Version:

- Cut at least 6 background squares prior to class.
- Refer to the back of your pattern for full fabric list

Helpful Tips:

- Label all your supplies with name tags.
- Bring a project bin to keep your fabric and notions organized.
