

French Rose

French Rose is a wonderful opportunity to learn raw edge, ragged applique. You can make a bedrunner, a lap quilt, or a full sized bed quilt. In this class you will learn the technique of making the roses, and we will discuss how to finish

Beginner quilters are welcome.

Finished size is up to you. The more roses you make, the bigger the quilt. The bedrunner for a queen takes 18 roses.

Pattern and materials available at Gigi's Fabric Shop

Materials/Supplies Needed: (are written on the back of the pattern) You can use a layer cake and add fat quarters of similar fabrics for roses. Purchase leaf, border and background fabric as required.

Supplies Needed for Day of Class:

Thread to match your roses (I used a neutral thread. Remember this will rag, so thread will not show as much.)

Sharp scissors for cutting back fabric. Applique scissors if you have them.

Pins

Sewing machine in good working order

Template plastic (heavy duty is best)

Fine point sharpie for marking templates

Frixion pen for marking fabric

New needle for your machine, since you will be sewing through several layers of fabric.

Thread and bobbins

You will learn: How to make rag roses on your background fabric

How to sort and select fabrics for each Rose

How to place Leaves and rose on your background We will discuss how to put your blocks together We will discuss quilting your finished quilt top

Homework prior to class....

Please cut at least twelve background squares, so that you can spend your class time making roses.

We will begin promptly, so plan on arriving on time. You will not need your sewing machine until later, since we will be working on cutting out roses and leaves.
