

Quilting 101

Learn the basics of quilting and make a lap quilt from start to finish.

Learn the basics of quilting in 12 hours of instruction. You will leave the class with a finished quilt top, and if you do your homework, you will be able to begin quilting your quilt sandwich. You will receive a booklet with some reference materials that will include a list of tools of the trade, vocabulary, how to sheets for binding, insight into copyrighting, color theory, needles and other tidbits.

Materials/Supplies Needed:

1 Layer Cake

2/3 yd of accent fabric

Supplies Needed for First Day of Class:

Sewing machines will be provided; however, you will need to supply your own thread and bobbins. You may purchase Janome pre-wound bobbins for \$1 each from instructor.

Rotary cutter with new blade

Glass head Pins

Small scissors

If you have a quilting ruler, you may bring it. Please mark all equipment with your name. If you do not have a ruler, you can use the shop rulers until you determine what works best for you.
