

Cover Up Sewing Machine Cover

Short Description: A cover for your sewing machine!!

Long Description: Cover Up is a sewing machine cover pattern with three different style options, so you can choose the best fit for your personality. Style One beautifully showcases a large scale print, Style Two can use up some much love scraps and Style Three adds a bit of wonky fun to your sewing space. Sewing machines come in a giant array of dimensions. The directions are written in such a way that every bit of the cutting instructions is based on the measurements of **YOUR** machine!

Pattern -Cover Up: The Sewing Machine Cover by Empty Bobbin sewing studio

Materials Needed: (as written on the pattern)

Main Color	¾ yard	¾ yard
Accent Strips	1/8 yard	1/8 yard
Decorative Panel	1/4 yard large scale print	(5) 1/8 yd cuts or assorted
	(1 yard if directional print)	scraps
Lining Fabric	1 yard	1 yard
Muslin	1 yard	1 yard
Batting	1 yard	1 yard

Supplies:

Review the pattern for other materials and options.

Supplies Needed for Day of Class:

- Sewing machine with appropriate piecing thread
- Walking foot and thread to match to quilt with
- Size 14 or Microtex needle
- Pins, rotary cutter, rulers (6 ½ x 12 is a useful size), cutting mat for personal use

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- Pencil, chalk, water soluble pen or thin marker to mark with
- Wonder clips

706 West Lumsden Road Brandon, Florida 33511 **HOMEWORK....**It is recommended to complete this before the day of the class to help ensure you finish the sewing machine cover the day of the class.

You will be measuring your machine, cutting the pieces, creating the pieced panel (styles 2 & 3 only) before class begins. If you are inserting piping to your pieced panel follow the directions on page 5. Complete this portion of the instructions as well in advance.

You will be learning how to measure & cut large pieces of fabric, piece fabrics together, quilt using a variety of desired techniques, and continue to develop your skills of reading patterns.

Read through the directions on the pattern to familiarize yourself with the information.

Let's Begin....

On page 2....Measuring Instructions: Follow the directions given in the pattern. *Measure twice, cut once!!* This step is critical to the finished size of the cover. Write the measurements you are using in the spaces given.

Example: Janome 9400

Machine width = 10 in. Machine height = 13 in. Machine length = 21 in.

Measurement A = height + height + width $-3 \rightarrow 13 + 13 + 10 - 3 = 33$ in. Measurement A = 33 in.

Measurement B = length + width -7 → 21 + 10 -7 = 24 in. Measurement B = 24 in.

Cutting Instructions: Follow the directions as given. This step applies for all decorative panels. If you are completing style 2 or 3 you will follow the directions on page 3 for creating the pieced panel. Follow the piping instructions on page 5 if you are adding this accent to your cover.

Example: Cutting Instructions for Janome 9400

From Accent Strip fabric, cut: (2) 1 ½" x 33" (measurement A)
From Decorative panel fabric, cut: (1) 6 ½" x 33" (measurement A)
From Main Color Fabric, cut: (1) 24" (measurement B) x 33" (measurement A)

Read through the directions given about centering or offsetting the cutting of the decorative panel.

We will begin with cutting the decorative panel and creating the top of the cover on page 4.
