

It is easier than you think to make this triangle quilt using a 60 degree triangle ruler.

Triangle Peaks has four sizes from Baby to Queen. You will learn to use the 60 degree triangle ruler to create the two different blocks that make up this quilt. You will also learn how to handle bias edges. This is a fat quarter friendly pattern.

Materials/Supplies Needed: Purchase Prints, Accent, and Background fabric according to the size you want to make. Amounts are on page 2 of pattern. You will also need an 8 /2" Triangle ruler. (You can use templates provided with pattern, but it will take longer and may not be as accurate.)

Sewing machine in good working order Neutral thread for piecing Rotary cutter with new blade Glasshead pins Small scissors Seam ripper Frixion pen 6 x 24" ruler
