Short Description:

This is a designer pillow, 8 " diameter by 20" long welted bolster pillow.

This is a pillow that will give your home the elegance it deserves. Learn how to make a designer pillow without the high price. You will learn how to sew a circle in a circle, make and attach welting, make covered buttons, and lastly tuft your pillow.

Materials/Supplies Needed: Shopping list on page 8. If you purchase 52" decorator fabric from another store, get 3/4 yard. If you purchase cotton fabric get 1 1/4 yard and same amount of interfacing, either sf101 or f911. Gigi's has the rest of the supplies, except decorative trim. Don't forget fiberfill for the muslin pillow form.

Supplies Needed for Day of Class:

- 1. Sewing machine with appropriate thread, zipper foot, walking foot, other feet
- 2. Size 12 or 14 needle
- 3. Pins, rotary cutter, rulers ($6\frac{1}{2}$ x 12 is a useful size), cutting mat for personal use
- 4. Small pair of scissors (curved are helpful)
- 5. Pencil, frixion pen and/or chalk to mark with
- 6. I will supply upholstery needle
- 7. I will bring glue gun
