Supply List Beginning Quilting 102: Quilting and Binding the Quilt

In this class we will finish a quilt- learn how to baste a quilt sandwich, machine quilt it using a walking foot (which works like a set of feed dogs on top of the fabric) and bind the edges. The class will start from a completed quilt top (60"x 60" MAX size).

- A completed, well pressed quilt top, 60"x 60" maximum size
- Sewing machine
- Walking Foot for your machine
- #1 or #2 safety pins, straight or curved, lots of them.
- Basic sewing tools- pins, seam ripper, scissors, etc.
- Thread to match top, a bit heavier than piecing thread, So Fine or Glide poly or King Tut cotton, recommended.
- A few scraps of fabric about 10' square- bring what you have. It's for practicing.
- Fabric:

	Baby size, 39"x 48"	Lap Size, 59"x 59'
Backing	1 1/2 yards	3 1/2 yards
Binding	1/2	5/8
Batting (a few inches longer and wider than quilt top)	Crib size or 1 1/4 yd from 60" wide bolt	Throw size or 1 3/4 yd from 60" wide bolt
