Wensleydale Quilt Foundation Paper Piecing Class

Supplies:

- Wensleydale Foundation Papers (15% off if purchased at RSF)
- Sewing machine, power cord, and manual
- Neutral thread for piecing, good quality cotton such as Aurifil is best
- Rotary cutter, small cutting mat, and ruler, 12" long ruler is most useful
- Thin, sharp straight pins or fabric glue stick
- Scissors and seam ripper
- Pencil or pen, and paper for note taking, if desired
- Add A Quarter Ruler (optional) or a post card sized piece of card stock

Fabrics:

This is a great project to use up scraps. The following are the cut sizes for each piece of the block:

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- Piece 1: 2 ½" x 3 ¾"
- Pieces 2 & 3: 1 ³/₄" x 3 ³/₄"
- Pieces 4 & 5: 2 ½" x 2 ¼"
- Pieces 6, 7, 8 & 9: cut 2-3" x 4", place pieces RST and cut diagonally
- Pieces 10 & 11: 3 ³/₄" x 3 ¹/₄"
- Pieces 12 & 13: 2 3/4" x 6 3/4"
- Pieces 14, 15, 16 & 17: cut 2-7 ½" x 6", place pieces RST and cut diagonally

****Materials purchased for this class are eligible for a 15% discount.

To save time in class, you can pre-cut your fabrics.

You are welcome to park in the alley and drop off your supplies before parking.
