



Chapter 1: Embroidery

Project: Candle Wrap

Burlap is a trendy material that can be easily transformed into accessories and scents for weddings, parties, decor and much more. See how this cute embroidered burlap and wrap will take your candle from drab to fab!



Supplies needed:

icon sewing machine with power cord

embroidery unit

Fabric and Stabilizer

Cut away stabilizer

1/4 yard Burlap

Cut a piece of burlap approximately 5 x 12"

Hint: to cut burlap straight, so you get a perfect frayed edge, find a vertical thread where you want to cut the fabric. Place a needle or small crochet hook under that thread and pull that thread out. Cut down the open space created in the burlap.

Thread

60 wt bobbin thread

Embroidery thread, colors of your choice to complete design (1 green, 2 flower colors)

Feet and Hoops

6D Dynamic Spring foot- embroidery foot

120 x 120 hoop

Needles:

75 Embroidery

Additional Supplies

1- 6" x 3" candle

1 1/2 yards of jute twine for ties

2-small buttons to embellish flower centers (optional)
