



Chapter 2: Exclusive Stitch Technique

Project: Decorative Drawstring Reticule

This small, elegant little bag uses some the exclusive techniques from the Pfaff *creative icon*. In this project we will incorporate stacked stitches and ribbon stitches, adding texture to this fun project.



icon sewing machine

cord

Foot pedal

Fabric and Stabilizer

1/4 yard linen, silk or cotton for body of bag

3/8 yard print cotton fabric for lining

1/4 yard iron on interfacing or stabilizer

Thread

Construction thread to match fabric

2 colors of embroidery thread to match ribbon

Feet

0A foot for construction

2A foot for decorative stitching

Additional Supplies

2-colors of 1/8" ribbon

Tassel for bottom of reticule

1 1/4 yard of cord or 1/2" wide ribbon for ties

Basic Sewing Supplies

Pins, scissors, rotary cutter, mat and ruler, fabric clips, fabric maker, chalk marker, etc.

From linen, silk or cotton cut

(2) 10" squares, back with fusible interfacing

(2) 10"x3" strips for bag top, backed with fusible interfacing, set these aside for later

From lining cut

(2) 8"x 2 1/4" pieces for casing

We will cut the bag lining later in the project
