



## Chapter 2: Embroidery Fonts/Lettering

This lesson will teach you how to work with the different fonts, arching and aligning your lettering with a design. This class will provide you with directions on how to finish off a book pocket pillow case.



### Supplies:

icon sewing machine with power cord

Embroidery Unit

#### Fabric and Stabilizer

1/2 yard print, Fabric A -Pillow fabric

1/2 yard accent, Fabric B-cuff

1/2 yard, Fabric C- for lining

1/3 yard solid, Fabric D - for pocket

1/3 yard fusible batting

Tear-A-Way stabilizer

Travel size pillow insert - Above and Beyond carries this item

#### Feet and Hoops:

6D Dynamic Spring foot- embroidery foot

1A

1/4" foot

260 x 200 creative Elite hoop

#### Thread:

Bobbin with light weight bobbin thread

Assorted embroidery threads to complete design

#### Needles:

75 embroidery needle

#### Other supplies:

small embroidery scissors

Iron

Rotary cutter and mat

Ruler

Usual Embroidery Supplies

**Cut Fabric as Follows:**

**Fabric A -**

(1) 13" x 16" -pillow back

(1) 13" x 8" -center panel

(2) 13" x 4 1/2" - side panels

(1) 8" lining square

**Fabric B -**

(1) 25 1/2" x 7 1/2" -cuff

**Fabric C -**

(1) 11" square - pocket front

**Fusible Batting**

(1) 11" square

**Tear Away Stabilizer**

To fit the 260 x 200 hoop
