



Chapter 3: Exclusive Stitch Technique

Project: Wonky Pieced Pillow Wrap

Wraps are a great way to take a basic pillow and change the look or season. The wonky piecing is embellished with the exclusive floating, radiant and lace edge stitches. Great stash buster!



Supplies:

icon sewing machine with power cord

Foot pedal

Fabric and Stabilizer

This pillow wrap was made for a 12" x 16" pillow

Assorted scraps, at least 9"h x 2 1/2' to 3 1/2"w for pillow wrap (jelly rolls are great for this project)

1/4 yard prints for pillow wrap backing, Fabric A

1/4 yard contrasting fabric for binding, Fabric B

Fusible Fleece

Wash-away stabilizer

Tear-away stabilizer

Threads

1 spool black embroidery thread

Black 60wt bobbin thread

1 spool 30 wt for lace edge stitch-color

Bobbin thread to match 30wt thread

Feet

1A

Sensormatic buttonhole

Additional Supplies

Glue stitch

2- 3/4" buttons

Needles

90/14 Topstitch

80/12 Universal

Basic Sewing Supplies

Pins, scissors, rotary cutter, mat and ruler, fabric clips, fabric maker, chalk marker, etc.

Cut:

Assorted fabric scraps at least 9" x 2 1/2" to 3 1/2", varying the width of the strips adds to the wonkiness

Fabric A-backing (1)-9" x 28"

Fabric B-binding (2)-2 1/2" x wof

Fusible Fleece

(1)-9" x 28"

Tear-A-Way

14-16- (1 1/4" x 10") strips, this will vary depending on how wide the strips are, great way to use up scraps

Wash-Away (3)-1 1/2" x 24" strips
