

AccuQuilt GO! Block of the Month – GO! Outside the Box

Join us every month as we cut and piece a new block from Eleanor's GO! Outside the Box book using the AccuQuilt GO! We'll make eight different 9" to 18" blocks following Eleanor's instructions, as we learn more about the AccuQuilt Qube and companion Angles and Corners.

Requirements:

GO! Outside the Box pattern book by Eleanor Burns

Sewing Machine with power cord and sewing supplies (or sew at home).

You do not have to bring your AccuQuilt cutter. We will have an 8" Qube to use. Other sizes can be done, but will not be provided.

Select Pattern from the book:

Before the first class, review and select your preferred setting pattern:

- Six Qube Sampler with Tutti Fruity Border – Pg 18
- Eight Qube Sampler with Tutti Fruity Border – Pg 20
- Nine Qube Sampler with Tutti Fruity Border – Pg 22
- Ten Qube Sampler with Geese Border – Pg 24
- Twelve Qube Sampler with Signature Border – Pg 26

Select Fabric based on pattern:

Match your pattern with 100% cotton fat quarters in a scrappy variety of colors and scales of prints.

Choose at least 14 fat quarters in light, medium and dark values*:

- Small scale prints
- 1-2 large scale prints
- Small checks and dots
- Narrow stripes
- Fabric suitable for fussy cuts
- Prints that read solid from a distance

*Note: Since we're going scrappy, you can always add fabric as your project progresses.

Select Background fabric based on pattern:

Match 1 light background that reads solid from a distance to your fat quarters**.

**Yardage is given for different sizes and border treatments, beginning on page 18 of your GO! Outside the Box book.
