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Beginners Serger Quilt using Accuquilt Strip Dye

- Babylock Serger that can do a Chain stitch with Threading guide
- Foot pedal
- 3 spools of serger thread to match your fabrics
- 1 spool of Fusible thread (Wonderfill brand- stocked at Above and Beyond)
- Serger Feet: Standard presser foot, Quilt guide, Fabric guide, Cover/Chain Stitch foot
- Overlock needles size 80
- Wonder clips or pins
- Any Accuquilt cutting system that can use the 2 1/2" strip dye
- the 2 1/2" strip dye
- Fabrics:
 - Strips: 1 light- 1 yd
 - 1 med/dark- 1 yd
 - One of these fabrics will be used for the outside border
 - Backing: 1 1/2" yd (this allows no piecing the back and you will have extra left)
 - Binding: 1/2 yd (this will give you enough if you cut your binding either 2 1/4 or 2 1/2")
- Batting- the overall size of our project is about 41 x 24" but need a few inches more to hang over while we quilt
- Scissors
- Quilters Select Free Fuse (if you hate to pin your layers together try Free Fuse) or Safety pins
- Mat, ruler and rotary cutter
- iron
- Sewing Machine with foot pedal
- Sewing thread that matches your binding fabric
- Stitch-in-the-Ditch foot or one that you like to use
- Metallic needle size 80 (i love this needle for topstitching the binding on)
- Usual Sewing Supplies
- Pen and paper for notes
