This pattern is a wonderful introduction to Judy Niemeyer's paper piecing techniques.

No paper piecing experience is necessary to make this wall hanging. Basic quilt piecing skills required.

In this two-day class you will learn:

Paper piecing technique

Curved piecing

Strip piecing with 2-1/2' strips

Pattern: **Autumn Pines**

Yardage Requirements are found on the back of the pattern.

Please read through the entire pattern especially if you have never made a Judy Niemeyer quilt. Read it again before the class. There is a lot to digest.

## **Pre-work before class**

- ❖ Check [www.quiltworx.com](http://www.quiltworx.com) for any **corrections** published after the Print Date on your pattern. This Print Date is found on the back page of the pattern. Include corrections, if any, with your pattern. **IMPORTANT**  
☺ **There are corrections to this pattern!!**
- ❖ Page 5 and Page 12: Place your fabric swatches in the boxes.
- ❖ Page 4. **Preparing the Foundation Papers.** Cut out the one page of NP328. Cut these pieces leaving about 1/4" of paper outside the black line.  
Cut out the pieces on the sheet TP374 leaving just a tiny bit of paper outside the black line.  
Page 12: **Group B: General Information Foundation Papers and Templates.** Follow the instructions to cut out the Units and Templates on NP567.

- ❖ If you are familiar with Judy patterns and feel comfortable doing so, go ahead and cut out your fabric following the instructions on page 5-6 and page 12. I will help with the cutting in class, so don't do this if you are not sure about it.
- ❖ That's it! Come with a smile and let's have lots of fun!

General Sewing Supplies- nothing optional, unless noted:

- Sewing machine in good working order, with a quarter-inch foot and a standard piecing foot, and machine manual.
- Normal sewing supplies, i.e., scissors, etc.
- Small iron and ironing board or mat; shop will have one or two for general use, but it's nice if you have your own to use
- 12" and 6" Add-a-quarter ruler. *If you don't already have these wait for class as Gretchen and possibly the shop will have the preferred wide versions of these rulers.*
- Fold template – ***I will provide one for each student***
- Fabric glue stick – UHU or other water- soluble glue stick ***I will provide one for each student***
- Purple Thang
- Glass head fine pins
- Medium size cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- New rotary blade
- Size 70/10 Microtex sharp needles
- Scissors (fabric and paper)
- Glue Pen (Fons & Porter, Sewline, or Avery)
- High quality cotton sewing thread; I like Aurifil thread for top and bobbin
- Scotch tape
- 8 Gallon size Ziploc bags
- Large paper clips
- **Highlighter** to mark pattern instructions; some students also find it helpful to put the pattern pages in sleeve protectors inside a binder.
