

Supply List for One-Block Wonders Encore

- Book: One-Block Wonders Encore
 - Large cutting matt
 - Both 45 and 60 mm rotary cutters with new blades
 - 60-degree triangle ruler
 - 24" quilter's ruler (and 18" quilter's ruler would be useful)
 - Sewing Machine in good working order with a new needle
 - Small iron and ironing surface
 - Flat head/flower pins
 - Task lamp recommended

- Instructor will bring design walls

Fabric Requirements for Kaleidoscope Hexagons: Please read pages 8 and 9 for recommended yardage amounts and other guidelines for fabric selection. (E.g. Authors recommend choosing fabric with two or three colors.) At minimum, I recommend you bring **1 ½ yards** of fabric for the kaleidoscope hexagons, which will provide enough for an 8" repeat and yield **36-38 hexagons**.

(Instructors sample measures approx. 31 x 39 inches and consists of 32 hexagons, 6 half hexagons and 36 hexagon slices at top and bottom as fillers. Each stack of six 43" long strips of fabrics will be cut into 3 ¾" strips and will yield 18 sets of hexagons from one strip. The more cubes you include in your design, the fewer kaleidoscope hexagons you will require.)

Cube Hexagons: Each cube will use **three fabrics** (light, medium and dark). Bring a selection of fabric that coordinate with your kaleidoscope hexagon fabrics. A selection of batiks and hand dyes will add interest. **Fat quarters will be sufficient.**
