## Summit Pack by Cloudsplitter Bags

## <u>Class Description:</u>

A perfect introduction to making your own bags, the Summit Pack by Cloudsplitter bags helps the intrepid sewist develop foundational skills that can help in all aspects of sewing! Learn multiple ways to insert zippers as well basics of interfacing and making a lined bag.

Students will need to bring a working sewing machine for this class.

## <u>Materials Needed:</u>

- Working sewing machine
- Paper scissors
- Clear/ Invisible Tape
- Iron
- Wool pressing mat
- Pressing cloth
- 28mm or 36mm rotary cutter
- Rotary cutting mat, recommended at least 24"x18"
- Wonder Clips or straight pins
- Frixion Pen, Chaco Liner, or preferred fabric marking utensil
- Ruler at least 18" in length
- 3/4 yard Exterior Main- quilting cotton 45" wide
- 3/4 yard Exterior Contrast/ Pocket Fabric quilting cotton 45" wide
- 1 yard Lining fabric quilting cotton 45" wide
- 4 yards Pellon SF101 or substitute another woven lightweight fusible interfacing
- 1/2 yard Pellon Flex Foam , or substitute headliner foam, Soft and Stable, or other foam interfacing
- One 13" or longer purse zipper (with larger pull and wide zipper tape)
- One 16" or longer purse zipper (with larger pull and wide zipper tape)
- Two 1" D-rings
- One 1" Swivel Clasp
- One 1" tri-glide slider
- Two nylon zippers, one 6" (for lining pocket), one 8" (for exterior pocket) standard coil to match (one for exterior, one for lining).
- Spray adhesive, or wonder-under for placing foam

Recommended fabric is quilting cotton, however denim or canvas may also be used. If you are unsure about what kind of fabric you would like, please call or stop by Sew Suite Studio for a fabric consultation.

## <u>Supplies suggested but not required:</u>

- Zipper foot
- Blind Stitch Foot
- Fabric glue
