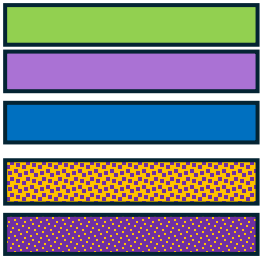


This pattern takes five 1-yard cuts of fabrics. All fabrics must be at least 40” useable width, not including selvages. The pattern assumes a ¼” seam allowance. This accuracy is key!

It is strongly recommended to pin a paper with the Fabric Numbers to your fabrics to keep it orderly.



A: Light

B: Medium

C: Dark** – *this is your “constant” will touch each fabric in the pattern.*

Make sure there is CONTRAST between this & the rest of your fabrics.

D: Large Scale Print – this is your “focal fabric”

E: Medium Scale Print – is border fabric, best as a companion fabric to the focal

CLUE 1 Cutting Instructions –Take care in cutting the correct sizes!

A: Light

- 4 cuts 2.5” X WOF
- 3 cuts 6.5” X WOF

B: Medium

- 2 cuts 2.5” X WOF
- 2 cuts 6.5” X WOF

C: Dark

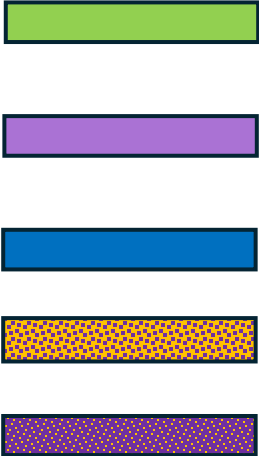
- 10 cuts 2.5” X WOF

D: Large Scale Print

- 2 cuts 2.5” X WOF
- 2 cut 6.5” X WOF

E: Medium Scale Print

- Do not cut for now (borders)



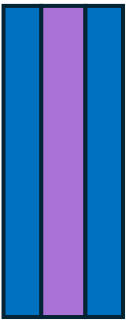
CLUE 2 Sewing the Strip Sets – Your Stripsets are made with the 2.5” x WOF cuts
It is strongly recommended to pin a label/paper to each strip set, to prevent any mix-ups.



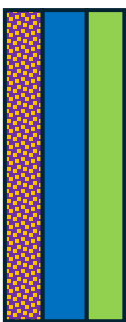
C-A-C
Make 2 sets
Press <out >



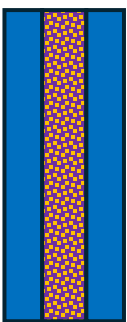
B-C-A
Make 1 set
Press >in <



C-B-C
Make 1 set
Press <out >



D-C-A
Make 1 set
Press >in<



C-D-C
Make 1 set
Press <out>

Bring all fabrics, cut/sewn and uncut to class!
