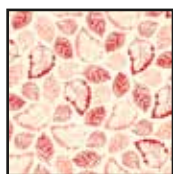

## Cutting Directions

**WOF** = Width of fabric from selvage to selvage.

### 23556-N Navy Floral

- Cut (2) 6 1/2" x **WOF** strips; recut into (12) 6 1/2" squares.
- Cut (6) 3" x **WOF** strips for border.

### 23557-EC Cream/Coral Leaf

- Cut (1) 3 1/2" x **WOF** strip.
- Cut (1) 2" x **WOF** strip.

### 23557-EN Cream/Denim Leaf

- Cut (1) 2" x **WOF** strip.

### 23557-N Navy Leaf

- Cut (1) 3 1/2" x **WOF** strip.
- Cut (1) 2" x **WOF** strip.

### 23559-NC Coral/Navy Chevron

- Cut (2) 6 1/2" x **WOF** strips; recut into (12) 6 1/2" squares.

### 23559-NW Denim/Navy Chevron

- Cut (1) 6 1/2" x **WOF** strip; recut into (6) 6 1/2" squares.

### 23528-CO Dark Coral Texture

- Cut (1) 2" x **WOF** strip.
- Cut (5) 1 1/2" x **WOF** strips for border.

### 23528-CZ Light Coral Texture

- Cut (1) 2" x **WOF** strip.

### 23528-N Navy Texture

- Cut (1) 2" x **WOF** strip.
- Cut (6) 2 1/4" x **WOF** strips for binding.

### 21520-Z White Tonal

- Cut (5) 3 1/2" x **WOF** strips; recut into (60) 3 1/2" squares.
- Cut (2) 3 1/2" x **WOF** strips.
- Cut (2) 2" x **WOF** strips.
- Cut (2) 9 3/4" x **WOF** strips; recut into (5) 9 3/4" squares and (2) 5 1/8" squares, then cut the 9 3/4" squares twice diagonally to make 20 setting triangles and cut the 5 1/8" squares in half diagonally to make 4 corner triangles.
- Cut (11) 2" x **WOF** strips for borders.

### Backing of Choice

- Cut (2) 63" x **WOF** strips for backing.

## Double Prism Blocks

*Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching.*

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 3 1/2" white square.
2. Place a marked square on 1 corner of a 6 1/2" navy floral square. Stitch on the marked line. Trim seam to 1/4". Press the white corner to the right side. Repeat on the opposite corner of the navy floral square to complete (1) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" Floral Double Prism block. Repeat to make 12 blocks total.

3. Repeat step 2 with marked white squares and the 6 1/2" coral/navy chevron squares to make (12) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" Coral Double Prism blocks. Repeat step 2 with the remaining marked squares and the 6 1/2" denim/navy chevron squares to make (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" Blue Double Prism blocks.



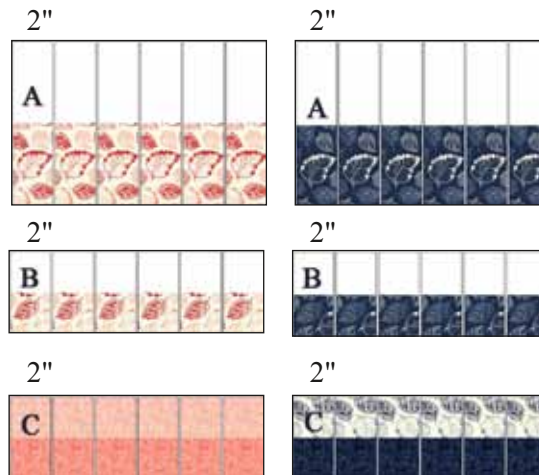
Coral Double Prism Block

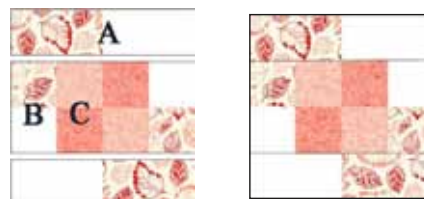
Blue Double Prism Block

## Four-Patch Center Blocks

1. Sew a 3 1/2" white strip lengthwise together with a 3 1/2" cream/coral leaf strip to make a strip set. Press seam toward the leaf strip. Crosscut the strip set into (20) 2" coral A segments. Repeat with 3 1/2" white and navy leaf strips to make a strip set and cut into (20) 2" navy A segments.

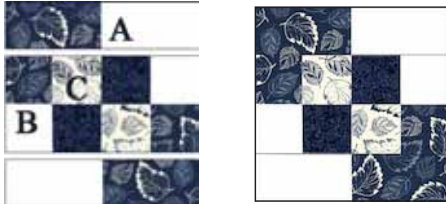


2. Stitch a 2" white strip lengthwise together with a 2" cream/coral leaf strip to make a strip set. Press seam toward the leaf strip. Crosscut the strip set into (20) 2" coral B segments. Repeat with 2" white and navy leaf strips to cut (20) 2" navy B segments.
3. Sew a 2" light coral texture strip lengthwise together with a 2" dark coral texture strip to make a strip set. Press seam toward the dark coral strip. Crosscut the strip set into (20) 2" coral C segments. Repeat with 2" cream/denim leaf and navy texture strips to cut (20) 2" navy C segments.
4. Join 2 coral C segments to make a 3 1/2" four-patch center unit. Press seam to 1 side. Stitch a coral B segment to opposite sides of the center unit to make the 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" center row. Press seams toward the four-patch center unit. Sew a coral A segment to opposite long sides of the center row to complete (1) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" Coral Four-Patch Center block. Press seams toward the A segments. Repeat to make 10 blocks total.

- Join 2 navy C segments to make a 3 1/2" four-patch center unit. Press seam to 1 side. Stitch a navy B segment to opposite sides of the center unit to make the 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" center row. Press seams toward the four-patch center unit. Sew a navy A segment to opposite long sides of the center row to complete (1) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" Navy Four-Patch Center block. Press seams toward the A segments. Repeat to make 10 blocks total.

## Quilt Assembly

*Note: Refer to the exploded quilt center diagram and the exploded quilt diagram throughout the following steps.*

- Arrange the Double Prism and Four-Patch Center blocks in 10 diagonal rows with the 9 3/4" white setting triangles and the 5 1/8" white corner triangles referring to the exploded quilt center diagram. Sew the blocks and triangles into the rows. Press all seams away from the Double Prism blocks.
- Join the rows to complete the 43" x 51 1/2" quilt center. Press seams to 1 side.

- Sew the 1 1/2" x **WOF** dark coral texture strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) 51 1/2" strips and (2) 45" strips. Sew the 51 1/2" strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the 45" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
- Sew the 2" x **WOF** white tonal strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) 53 1/2" strips and (2) 48" strips for second border and (2) 61 1/2" and (2) 56" strips for the fourth border. Stitch the 53 1/2" strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the 48" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
- Sew the 3" x **WOF** navy floral strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) 56 1/2" strips and (2) 53" strips. Stitch the 56 1/2" strips to the long sides and the 53" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
- Sew the 61 1/2" white tonal strips to the long sides and the 53" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips to complete the quilt top.
- Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim the top and bottom edges to make a 63" x 72" backing piece. The seam will be side to side on the back of the quilt.
- Layer, quilt, and bind using your favorite methods and the navy texture binding strips to complete the quilt.
