

Hemming ready-to-wear is easy when you know how to mark it and the best method and stitches to use. Let Pattie Otto from Great Copy Patterns show you how simple hemming can be. Pattie has over 35 years of alterations experience and has worked at a local menswear shop, including teaching Ingrim employees how to do professional alterations. She will demonstrate several hems for various fabrics and then help you select the correct method for your garment. This is a hands-on class. If you

Class also includes cutting and construction assistance as well as interfacing tips while you create your shirt. Both shirts are sized Ex –Small to 3X.
