

A “CRABBY” LITTLE QUILT

Just two easy foundation pieced blocks combine to make the crabs. Then you will learn to use Fabric Magic or Bosal Stitch & Seam to create the perfect texture for their ‘shells.’ You’ll be learning two techniques in this great class.

Materials list:

Fabric

Each crab requires a red fabric 9” x 18”. A ¼ yd. or fat quarter will yield 2 crabs. There are 8 crabs in the pattern (so, one yard or 4 fat quarters – not all the fabrics have to be the same!)

¼ yd. red-orange for middle border

1 ¼ yds. light blue

1 yd. medium-light blue

½ yd. medium-dark blue

1 ½ yds. dark blue

Backing fabric

Wash, dry and press the fabrics.

Pattern – “Feeling Crabby” by Patterns by Annie

BEFORE CLASS, MAKE 8 COPIES OF EACH PATTERN SHEET.

Fabric Magic – 1 pkg. 30” x 18” or Bosal Stitch n’ Seam

16 black buttons for the eyes (**will be available in class**)

Rotary cutter -- with a new blade

Ruler -- 6” x 24”

Rotary cutter mat

Small scissors

Paper scissors or paper rotary cutter

Pins

Pencils – a red colored pencil is helpful

Red thread

Neutral colored thread -- wind two or three bobbins before class

Other basic sewing supplies you like to use

Sewing machine

Extra sewing machine needles
