Supply list

- Embroidery/Sewing machine in good working order w/ IQ Designer, power cord, embroidery foot, Embroidery Hoop (must be able to do a 6.5"x6.5" design), bobbins, USB
- Baby Lock Ultra Soft for star blocks
- Cut Away Stabilizer
- Fabric
 - ⅓ yard for Star block Background
 - ½ yard for Sashing/Borders
 - o 1/4 yard for Corner Stones
 - o 1 ½ yards for Backing
 - o ½ yard for Binding
- 18" x 54" batting
- Embroidery Threads I used 4 colors for the Ohio Star blocks and 2 colors for the quilting
- Embroidery bobbin thread (Baby Lock machines like Finishing Touch)
- Regular sewing thread & bobbin for construction
- MonoPoly thread (optional)
- Embroidery Needles 75/11
- Hoop Grip (optional)
- Sewing feet:
 - o "J" or favorite foot for 1/4" seams
 - Edge Joining Foot
 - Walking foot or DDF
 - Quilt Binding Foot
- General sewing supplies (Stiletto, Tweezers, Lint Roller, Scissors, Pins, Ruler, Rotary Cutter, marking tools, etc.)

Sample finished size approximately 11.25" x 28.5". Ohio Star block is 6.5" x 6.5".

The yardage given above is enough to increase the finished size to approximately 15" x 39". You would need a hoop large enough to accommodate a 9" x 9" design.
