

Three-yard Quilt with Pat Brousil

“BEST FRIENDS”

Two sessions:

March 24th, 10:30am – 1:30pm *plus*

March 31st, 10:30am – 1:30pm

BEST FRIENDS is a quilt made with one yard each of three different coordinated fabrics. Virtually all of the fabric is used. It introduces the techniques used in strip piecing and making half-square triangles. Students should be comfortable using the rotary cutter and sewing $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams before taking the class.

Supply list:

Fabric for a lap quilt size 43" x 61"

1 yard each of 3 coordinated fabrics

3 yards for backing

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding -- if you want to do a double fold binding

I used extra from a wide backing fabric.

Note: The cutting requirements are very tight. It is recommended that you do **not** wash the fabrics.

Main fabric for larger sizes

Twin Size Quilt 63" x 81" 2 yards each of 3 coordinated fabrics

Queen Sized Quilt 96" x 105" 4 yards each of 3 coordinated fabrics

Book – “Easy Does It” by Donna Robertson

Rotary cutter -- with a new blade

Ruler -- 6" x 24"

Square ruler – 6" or 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " preferred

Rotary cutter mat

Small scissors

Pins

Pencils for light and dark fabric

Neutral colored thread -- wind two or three bobbins before class

Other basic sewing supplies you like to use

Sewing machine
