

Beginner Quilting: YELLOW BRICK ROAD

In this class you will learn quilting terminology, how to use rotary cutting equipment correctly and the importance of accurate measuring and piecing. To finish the top more quickly, or if you are a beginner, we recommend you start with the “baby quilt” size (it’s a small throw, not just for babies!).

Supplies:

Fabric:

	Baby Quilt	Lap Quilt	Twin Quilt
	48” x 48”	57” x 75”	66” x 93”
# of fat quarters	6	12	18
Border & binding	1 ½ yards	2 yards	2 ¼ yards
Backing	3 yards	3 ½ yards	6 yards

The pattern recommends that you do not wash the fabrics.

Pattern -- Yellow Brick Road by Terry Atkinson

Rotary cutter -- with a new blade

Ruler -- 6” x 12”

Rotary cutter mat

Small scissors

Pins

Neutral colored thread -- wind two or three bobbins before class

Other basic sewing supplies you like to use

Sewing machine in good working condition (*you should know how to use your machine before taking this class*)

Optional -- flannel or other fabric to pin pieces on
