

DRUNKARD'S PATH TABLE RUNNER

The Drunkard's Path is traditionally a curved piecing design. Terry Atkinson developed a machine applique method to achieve the same look. Quick and easy way to get the same look. This class teaches the basics of machine applique.

Materials list:

Fabric

22 – 5" squares A pre-cut packet of squares works great.

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard for background

1 package of fusible web -- Steam A Seam 2 or a Floriani product

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard for backing

18" x 45" cotton batting

Wash, dry and press the fabrics.

Pattern – Drunkard's Path Table Runner by Cut Loose Press

Creative Grids Round Up Tool

Rotary cutter -- with a new blade

Ruler -- 6" x 12"

Rotary cutter mat

Small scissors

Pins

Neutral colored thread -- wind two or three bobbins before class

Other basic sewing supplies you like to use

Sewing machine
