- 1" Hexie Papers (available in store)
- Fabric Scissors
- Thread Snips
- Seven 3" wide fabric strips
- 50wt thread to match fabrics
- Size 9 or 10 hand needles
- Fabric Glue Stick
- Pins and pincushion
- Comfortable thimble
- Small ruler
- Wonderclips (optional)
