Let's learn about Embroidering on Towels. We will discuss stabilizers, toppers, choosing designs and placement of designs.

Supply List:

- Embroidery Machine in good working order w/ cord, embroidery foot, 4x4 hoop, flash drive, etc.
- Stick Tear Stabilizer such as Baby Lock Stick Tear or Floriani Perfect Stick Tearaway
- Topper such as Baby Lock Press Film, Floriani Heat n Gone, Sulky Solvy, Baby Lock Hydro Melt or Stabilize It
- Embroidery Needle 75/11
- Extra bobbins if you want to do matching bobbin thread
- Towel
- Design to fit 4x 4 hoop and less than 10,000 stitches. When choosing your design be mindful of the nap of your towel. A "redwork" style design will look much better on a kitchen towel than on a towel with loft (such as a bath towel).
- Thread for your chosen design
- KK2000 or basting spray
- General embroidery supplies (snips, tweezers, small ruler, etc.)

My sample is a hand towel with a shell design from the Baby Lock Destiny (#2-20). I used Sulky thread 1217, 1082 & 1837.
