- Scrap fabric for Beehives (4 different yellow fabrics; 1 black)
- Embroidery Thread to coordinate with your Beehive fabrics
- Batting ³/₄ yard

PRIOR TO CLASS:

- 1. Download your CD to a Thumb Drive in the format best suited for your embroidery machine. (PES) for BabyLock
- 2. Go to page 18 in your book.
 - a. Cut your fabrics.
 - b. Sew all seams with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Accuracy is important.
 - c. Follow directions 1 7. Your finished block should measure $11" \times 11"$
 - d. Bring your completed 11" block with you to class.
