Materials list:

Fabric

6 repeats of a multi-colored fabric. If the repeat is less than 18", you may want to purchase 12 repeats depending on the size of the quilt you want to make.

Border fabric is best purchased after you have made the blocks.

Backing fabric amount will depend on the finished size of your quilt.

Binding -- ½ - 1 yd. depending on the size of your quilt.

It is best not to wash the fabrics.

Book – One Block Wonders by Maxine Rosenthal

Rotary cutter -- with a new blade

Ruler -- 6" x 24"

Rotary cutter mat

60-degree triangle ruler -- 4" -- 6" high

Small scissors

Pins -- The flat flower headed pins work best.

Neutral colored thread -- wind two or three bobbins before class

Other basic sewing supplies you like to use

Sewing machine

¼" presser foot

Flannel or other fabric to pin pieces on for second session
