The Stack N Whack method engages your eyes and mind as new designs emerge and change like patterns in a kaleidoscope. Layer fabrics and cut to get unique designs. A fun and easy process.

Materials list:

Fabric

6 design repeats of a large scale print

Yardage will vary depending on the length of the repeat.

This could also be your border. You will have enough.

1 yd. **each** of 2 coordinating fabrics

Backing and binding yardage will depend on how big you make your quilt.

Do not launder your fabric.

Book — Magic Stack-n-Whack Quilts by Bethany Reynolds

Rotary cutter -- with a new blade

Ruler -- 6" x 24"

A ruler with a 60 degree angle. Can be the 6" x 24" or a smaller ruler.

Rotary cutter mat

Small scissors

Pins — flat-headed ones work best for this technique

Neutral colored thread -- wind two or three bobbins before class

Other basic sewing supplies you like to use

Sewing machine
