Supply list:

Your class fee includes a basic kit. This kit will include your foam, batting and pre-drilled wooden base.

Additional Supplies:

Creative Grids 15 degree triangle ruler

Your sewing machine, in good working order with power cord, foot pedal, sewing feet (general purpose/zig zag foot or 1/4 inch foot), etc.

You favorite sewing tools: scissors, seam ripper, etc.

Upholstery needles (these are MUCH larger than regular needles and are a must have for the tuffet)

Cover button

Feet for your tuffet: these may be found at Lowes or Home Depot, ask in the lumber dept. I used newel posts for a fence for mine and they worked wonderfully!! (and they were cheap!!) There are also some wonderful feet available online. Make sure the feet you choose have long screws, for stability.

Fabric: for the purpose of this class, you may make this tuffet with 1 or 2 fabrics. You will need one yard of fabric total. If you are using 2 fabrics (to create a strip effect), a half yard of each.

HOMEWORK

Before you come to class, please wash and press your fabrics, then cut into strips measuring 3" x 20"

MAKE SURE TO BE ACCURATE IN YOUR CUTTING!!!

I will bring twine and an industrial stapler to help with finishing.
