

Westalee Ruler Table Runner

NOTE: THIS IS A FREE MOTION QUILTING CLASS USING WESTALEE QUILTING RULERS

Supply list:

Your MACHINE, in good working order, with POWER CABLE and FOOT CONTROL

FREE MOTION QUILTING FOOT appropriate for your machine. This can be either the Westalee Foot or the Baby Lock foot.

Westalee 12" ARC RULER template. This came with the Westalee foot in MOST starter sets. The ruler IS available separately if you don't have it.

QUILT SANDWICH measuring 13" x 36" This is larger than you will need, as we will be squaring up the finished project, which will measure 11 1/2" x 31 1/2" Your backing fabric should measure about an inch large than your top in both directions. NOTE: DO NOT USE A BUSY PRINT FOR YOUR TOP. THE WHOLE POINT OF THIS IS TO SEE YOUR QUILTING! And please have your sandwich prepared before class. Do Not Pin or spray baste.

THREAD: I STRONGLY recommend using a 50 weight thread for this project. Mettler, or Aurifil. Your main thread should contrast with your fabric. your secondary thread should be more subtle, though it shouldn't disappear entirely.

BOBBINS: please wind 2 bobbins of each of your threads before coming to class.

MARKING TOOL. Frixion pen, wash away marker, etc. do not use an air away marker. It is summer now, and the humidity will make it disappear VERY quickly.

a 7" square ruler or template (this can be made from template plastic or cardboard, or it can be a 7" cutting ruler)

OTHER HELPFUL ACCESSORIES: The following are highly recommended: Quilting gloves (machingers, grabarros, etc.), Extension table for your machine, Super slider for your extension table.
