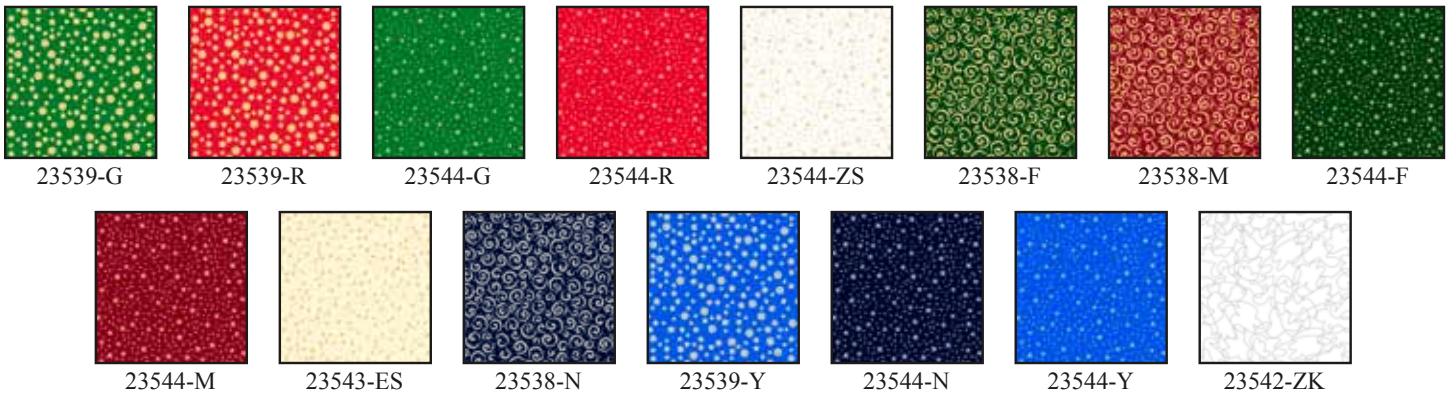

Cutting

Note: Quilting Treasures' fabric width is 43"/44". Fat quarters = 18" x 21"-22"

Note: All strips should be cut across the width of the fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless noted otherwise.

A. 23539-G (Green/Gold Dots) 23538-F (Forest/Gold Curly Cues) 23538-N (Navy/Silver Curly Cues)

- Cut twenty 3⅞" squares.
- Cut each square in half diagonally to yield forty half-square triangles.

Note: Start cutting squares as close to the selvage as possible to ensure that all squares can be cut from fat quarter.

B. 23539-R (Red/Gold Dots) 23538-M (Wine/Gold Curly Cues) 23539-Y (Royal/Silver Stars)

- Cut twenty 3⅞" squares.
- Cut each square in half diagonally to yield forty half-square triangles.

Note: Start cutting squares as close to the selvage as possible to ensure that all squares can be cut from fat quarter.

C. 23544-G (Green/Gold Stars) 23544-F (Forest/Gold Stars) 23544-N (Navy/Silver Stars)

- Cut one 3⅞" strip; subcut six 3⅞" squares.
- Cut each square in half to yield twelve half-square triangles. From remainder of strip, cut six 2" squares.
- Cut five 2½" strips for binding.

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D. 23544-R (Red/Gold Stars)

23544-M (Wine/Gold Stars)

23544-Y (Royal/Silver Stars)

- Cut one 3 7/8" strip; subcut four 3 7/8" squares.
- Cut each square in half to yield eight half-square triangles. From remainder of strip, cut six 2" squares.

E. 23544-ZS (White/Gold Stars)

23543-ES (Ecru/Gold Vine)

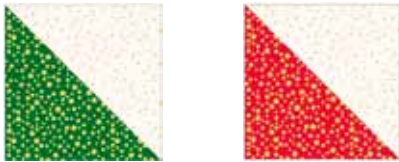
23542-ZK (White/Silver Scribble)

- Cut three 3 7/8" strips; subcut thirty 3 7/8" squares.
- Cut each square in half to yield sixty half-square triangles.
- Cut six 2" strips; subcut sixteen 2" x 12 1/2" strips.

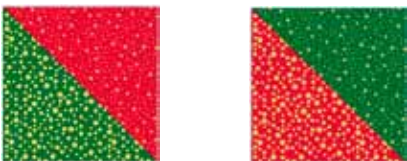
Construction

1. Referring to diagrams, sew half-square-triangles together to create the following number of units of each fabric combination.

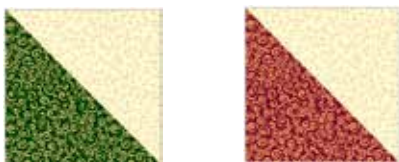

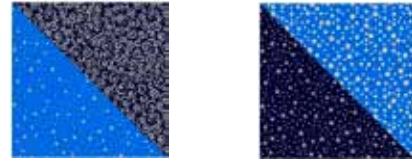

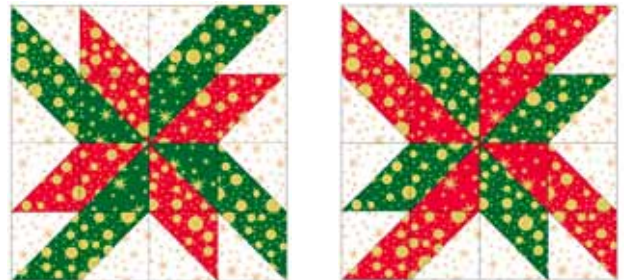

2. Referring to block diagrams, sew half-square triangle units into rows. Press seams in opposite direction from row to row. Sew rows together; press.

3. Lay blocks in order as shown in image. Sew one (E) 2" x 12½" strip between each block as well as at both ends of the runner. Press toward the strips.
4. Sew top and bottom frame strips using remaining (E) 2" x 12½" strips and (C) and (D) 2" squares. Press toward the squares. Sew frame strips to runner; press.

Finishing

1. Cut backing fabric in half lengthwise. Sew pieces together along short sides. Press.
2. Layer runner, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
3. Trim layers even with runner top.
4. Prepare binding using (C) 2½" strips. Sew binding to runner using your preferred method.
