## John 3:16

Quilt Finishes 20" x 24"

## Cuttina:

Fabric A: Trim "John 3-16" saying to 10" x 14" rectangle.

Fabric B: Frame Fabric - 1/4 Yard (Green on pattern)

Cut 1 - 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub Cut:

16 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

Cut 2 - 13/4" x WOF strips. Sub Cut:

2 - 1 3/4" x 12 1/2" rectangles

2 - 1 3/4" x 14" rectangles

Cut 1 - 1 3/4" x WOF strip for Binding and use leftover from the above strip to finish binding.

Fabric C: Accent Fabric - 1/4 Yard (Gold on pattern)

Cut 1 - 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: 8 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.

Cut 1 - 2 ½" x WOF strip. Subcut: 8 - 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles, AND 8 - 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares. Note: You can use the above 4 ½" strip for 2 ½" squares as well.

Fabric D: Background Fabric - 1/4 Yard (Light Yellow on pattern)

Cut 2" - 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub Cut:

12 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

12 - 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

## **SEWING:**

1. Sew a 1 3/4" x 14" Fabric B rectangle to Top and Bottom of the "John 3-16" saying. Repeat to sew a 1 3/4" x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B rectangle to Left and Right of the above saying. Press toward the Frame fabric. Make 1 Framed Saying.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Make 4 - C units

2. Use  $4 - 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares, and  $16 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B squares. Draw a diagonal line on the WS of the Fabric B squares. Sew each Fabric B square on the upper right and lower left corners. Trim the outer corner with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press. Repeat to finish the other 2 corners. Cut away the extra fabrics. Press seam toward the corner. Make 4 - A units.










Make 4 - A units

3. Use  $4 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$  x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$  Fabric C rectangles, and  $4 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$  x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$  Fabric D rectangles. Sew each of these fabrics together on the long side to make 4 - B units. Press seam open.

Make 4 - B unite

4. Use 4 - 4 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C squares, and 8 - 2 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric D squares. Repeat Step 2 sewing to the Top Right and Top Left corners to make 4 - C units.

5. Use 4 -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D rectangles, and 4 -  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares. Repeat Step 2 to make 2 - D units, and 2 - E units, as shown.




6. Use  $4 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C rectangles, and  $4 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D squares. Repeat Step 2 to make 2 - F units, and 2 - G units, as shown.



## <u>Assembly</u>

1. Use 2 of each: F, G, C and 4 - 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric D rectangles. Sew a Fabric D rectangle on top of a F and G unit. Press seams open. Make 2 of each as shown below. Sew a Left and Right set to the left and right of C - unit. Make 2 rows. Use the diagram below for row placement. Press seams open.




2. Use 2 - D units, 2 - E units, 4 - A units, 2 - C units, and 4 - B units. Use the diagram below to put these together. Make 2 rows. Press seams open.



Make 2 "Top & Bottom" rows

- 3. Use 2 "Left & Right" rows, and 2 "Top & Bottom" Rows. Sew "Left & Right" Rows to Left and Right of the "Framed Saying". Sew "Top & Bottom" Rows to Top and Bottom of the "Framed Saying". Press seams open.
- 5. When your quilt has been quilted, add binding and enjoy!





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
