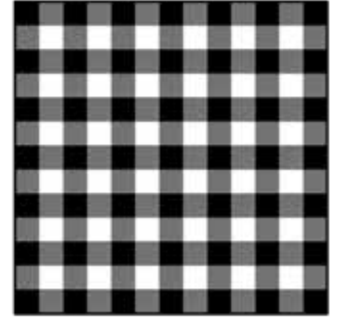

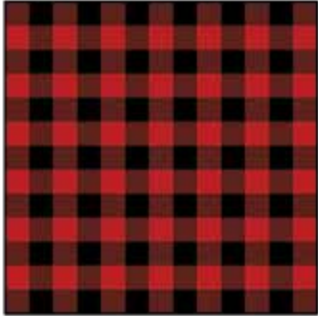

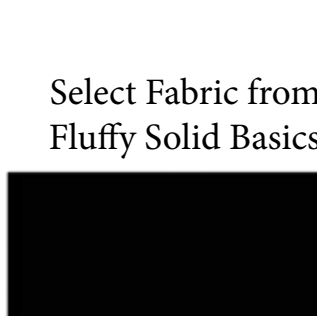

Materials

1 panel	Gnome Panel - Multi (A)	F9277P-89
½ yard	Fluffy Solid - Black (B)	Fluffy Solid-Black
½ yard	Bias Plaid - Multi (C)	F9276-89
1 ½ yards	Gnomes and Woodland Animals - Multi (D)	F9266-89
1 ⅛ yards	Buffalo Check - Red/Black (E)	F9270-89*
1 ⅛ yards	Buffalo Check - Black/White (F)	F9270-9
½ yard	Stacked Gnomes - Multi (G)	F9271-89
⅝ yard	Snowflake - Multi (H)	F9268-89
⅜ yard	Snowflake - Red (I)	F9268-88
1 ⅜ yards	Tossed Gnomes - Black (J)	F9273-99
5 ⅓ yards	Tossed Snowmen - Red (Backing)	F9272-88

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gnome Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23" x 42" rectangle centered on the panel.

From the Fluffy Solid - Black (B), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 42" strips.
- (2) 3" x 28" WOF strips.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (C), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 3" x 31 ½" WOF strips.

From the Gnomes and Woodland Animals - Multi (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 51 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Buffalo Check - Red/Black (E), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 65 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 41 ½" WOF strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Buffalo Check - Black/White (F), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 49" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 69 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 71" strips.
- (3) 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ¼" x 55 ½" strips.

From the Stacked Gnomes - Multi (G), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 45" strips.

From the Snowflake - Multi (H), cut:

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 69 ½" strips.

From the Snowflake - Red (I), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 61" strips.

From the Tossed Gnomes - Black (J), cut:

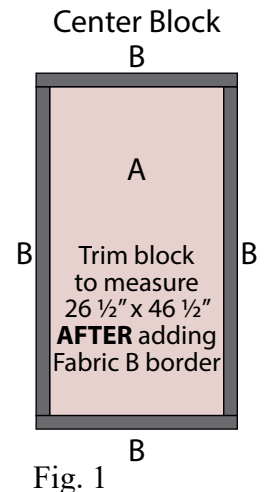
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 73 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 71" strips.

From the Tossed Snowmen - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 95" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 79" x 95" back.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 3" x 42" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 42" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3" x 28" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. **Trim the block to measure 26 ½" x 46 ½"** to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



Quilt Top Assembly

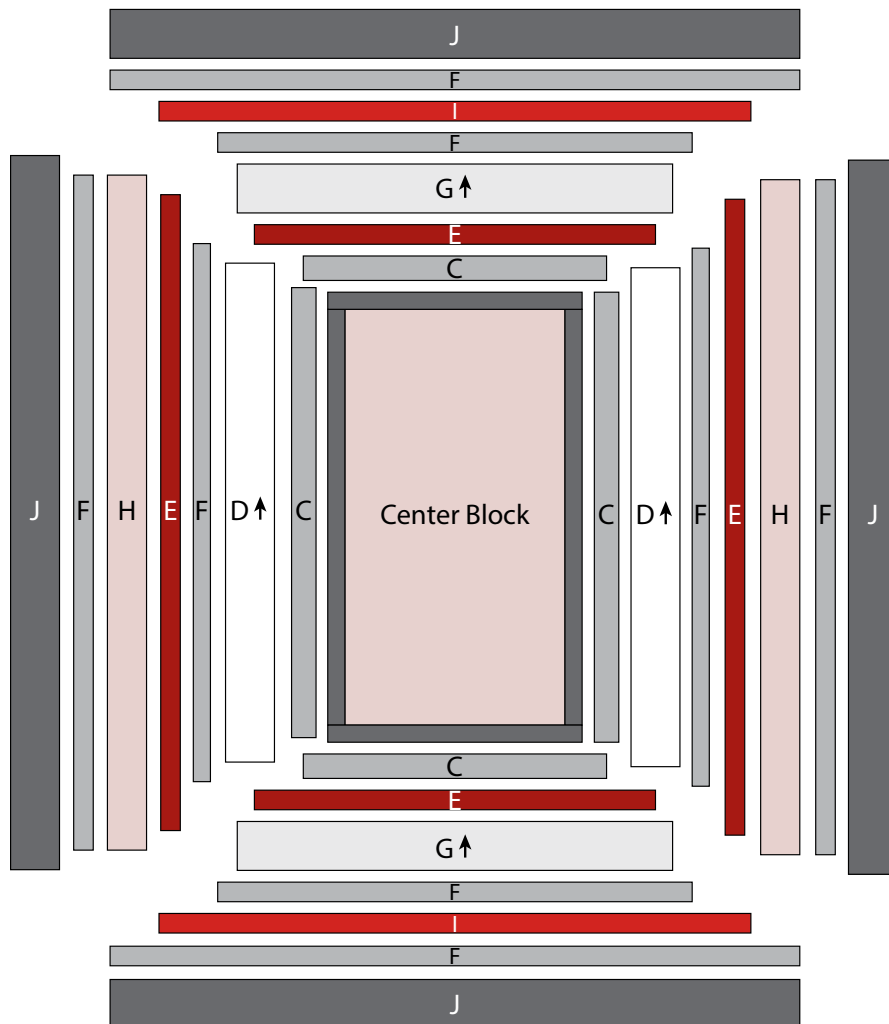
(The arrows in the Quilt Layout represent the fabric print direction. Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

2. Sew (1) 3" x 46 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 31 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
3. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 51 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block.
4. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
5. Sew (1) 2 ¼" x 55 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 45" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 65 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 49" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 69 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 69 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 61" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 73 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 71" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 71" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.
