# Simple Rail Quilt



What do you need?

## Fabric:

Quilt Top:

3 Fabrics:  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard of 3 different fabrics

Or

6 Fabrics:  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard of 6 different fabrics

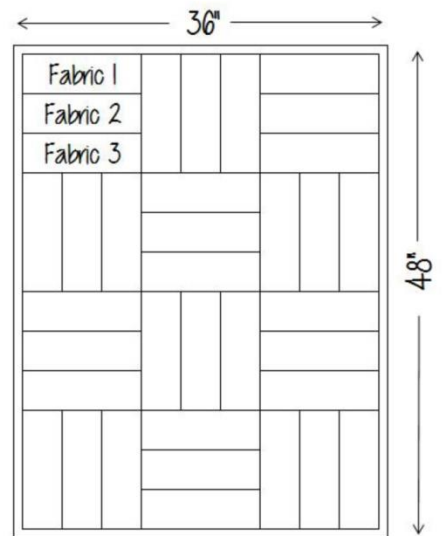
Backing:  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  yards

Binding:  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard

Batting: 1 Package Warm & Natural  
Baby Size 45x60

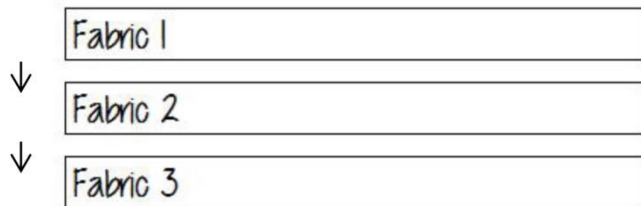
Embroidery Floss — 1 skein

Thread

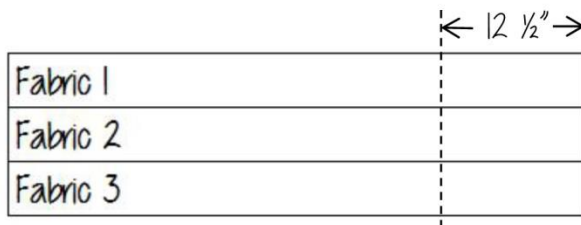


The  
Quilt  
Spot

From Quilt Top Fabric cut strips  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " by the WOF. With a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew 3 strips together (Make 4). Press seams open.

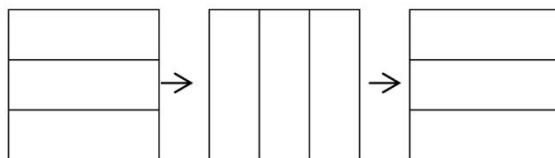


Trim down to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square blocks. You should have 12 total blocks.

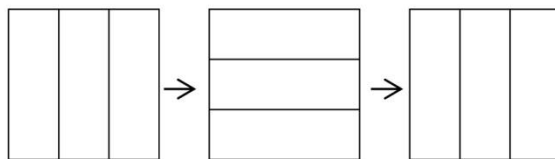


Alternate the layout by rotating the blocks to the right as shown.

Row 1 & 3



Row 2 & 4



Sew the rows the together. Quilt as desired and bind.
