

This quick and easy project is also super simple to resize. If you would like a longer runner, simply add more rows, wider add more columns. Just add 1 1/2" for every column you add when you are ready to cut the inner and outer borders. **Finished size 12 1/2" x 28 1/2".**

## **Fabric Requirements**

Scappy Center – (96) 2" Squares of Various Fabrics

Inner Border & Binding – 1/3 Yard


Outer Border – 1/6 Yard

Backing – 1/2 Yard

Optional – One panel of 1 1/2" Finished Tensisters Easy Piecing Grid

## **Cutting Instructions**

- **Scappy Center** - Cut (96) 2" squares from scraps. We suggest a minimum of eight different fabrics, but more variety is encouraged!
- **Inner Border** - Cut (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. After measuring your quilt center, cut (2) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles for the inner borders. Adjust the length if needed to match the size of your quilt center.
- **Binding** – Cut (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding and piece them end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open.
- **Outer Border** – Cut (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Cut (2) 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles for the outer borders. Adjust the length if needed to match the size of your quilt center.



## **Piecing Instructions**

1. Layout the 2" scrappy squares in 12 rows of 8 taking care to not place the same fabrics side by side. Visit our YouTube channel for directions on using the optional Easy Piecing Grid.
2. Sew 8 squares together to make one row. Repeat to make 11 additional rows. Press the first row to the left, the 2<sup>nd</sup> row to the right, alternating the pressing direction between rows so you can nest your seams when connecting the rows.
3. Sew the 12 rows together and press all of the horizontal seams in one direction.
4. Measure the width of your quilt center to determine the length to cut your inner and outer borders. Cut two inner and two outer border rectangles to this length.
5. Sew the long side of an inner border to an outer border rectangle and press towards the inner border. Repeat for the other end of the runner to create two border sections.
6. Sew a border section to each end of the scrappy quilt center. Press towards the inner border.
7. Quilt as desired and bind using your favorite binding method.
