

Corrections for A-Z Alphabet Quilt

(All corrections are in **Red**)



Cutting Instructions

Fabric A – 28207-Z (Panel)

- 1). Cut panel **24 1/2" x 42 1/2"** centering design (black border should show). **There will not be a red border on each side of the panel.**

Fabric B – 28208-X (Large Stripe fabric)

- 1). Cut (four) stripe repeats on the length of the fabric. Each repeat should be cut approximately 9 3/4" wide. Trim (two) border strips to 70" long (Outer Border).

Fabric F -28211-Z (White Circles on Blue fabric)

- 1). Cut (**one**) 1 1/2" strip; sub-cut (four) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles **omit cutting (four) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. These pieces are no longer needed** (Block Frames).
- 2). Cut (**three**) 2 1/2" strips; sub-cut (four) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles and (**eight**) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles (Block Frames).

Fabric H – 28211-R (White Circles on Red fabric)

- 1). **Delete**
- 2). Cut (six) 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. From this pieced strip cut (two) 1 1/2" x 48" strips and (two) **1 1/2" x 66" strips.**

Construction

Step 6 – Sew (one) **2 1/2" x 8 1/2"** (Fabric F) rectangle to the top of the unit from **Step 5**. Sew (one) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" (Fabric F) rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press seams toward the rectangles. Repeat **Steps 5 & 6** to make (four) blocks (see **Diagram 3**).

(**Make 4 - 8 1/2" x 9 1/2" blocks**)

Step 7 – Refer to the (Quilt Layout Diagram) to arrange and sew (five) blocks in a row for each side of the panel. Double-check that you have the blocks turned and positioned correctly. **Note: the blue blocks are now directional, make sure that the 9 1/2" length is vertical and the 8 1/2" length is horizontal.** Press seams open or to one side. Repeat. Sew each set of blocks to the sides of the panel. Press seams toward the panel.

Step 9 – Sew (one) **1 1/2" x 66"** (Fabric I) strip to the inside of (one) longer (Fabric B) border strip matching centers of strips. The border strip will extend beyond both ends of the (Fabric I) strip. Press seam toward the (Fabric I) strip. Repeat to make a second side border.

Outside Borders

The outside borders can be done in two different ways. (**Option 1**) has the **animals** on the outer edge of the quilt while (**Option 2**) has the **letters** on the outer edge of the quilt. You will cut the large stripe differently for (**Option 1**) than you would for (**Option 2**).

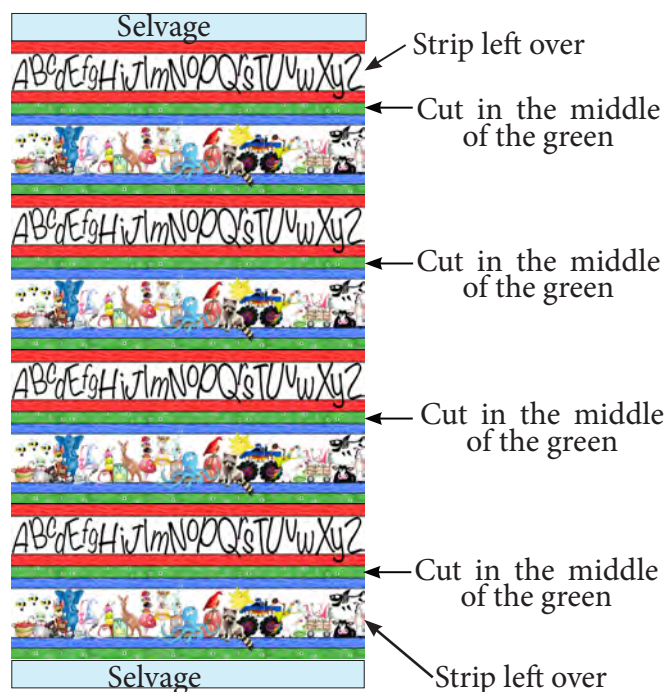
Animals on the outer edge of the quilt

Option 1). To make the quilt the way it is shown on the pattern cover you will need to do the outside borders in this manner. Cut the large stripe as shown below in (**Diagram 1**). You will have 3 full strips of the border approximately 90" in length. You will also have a strip of the letters and a strip of the animal images both approximately 90" in length. The selvage will be attached to both of these pieces (see **Diagram 2**). Do not cut off the selvage until after you sew the fabrics together. To make the 4th full stripe you will need to sew the remaining letter strip to the remaining animal strip. Place the letters strip (RST) onto the bottom of the animal strip with the selvages together. Sew along the edge of the selvage the entire 90" length of the strip (see **Diagram 3**). Trim selvage leaving a 1/4" seam allowance and press seam open. You now have the 4th border strip that matches the other 3. Continue and

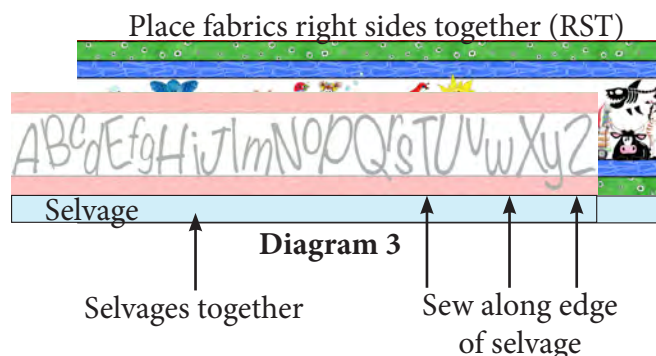

Option 2). This option will place the letters on the outer edge of the finished quilt. You will cut the large stripe according to the diagram below (**Diagram 4**). Your finished quilt will look like the finished quilt picture as shown in (**Diagram 5**). You will assemble the quilt according to the directions. Trim selvage after assembly leaving a 1/4” seam allowance.

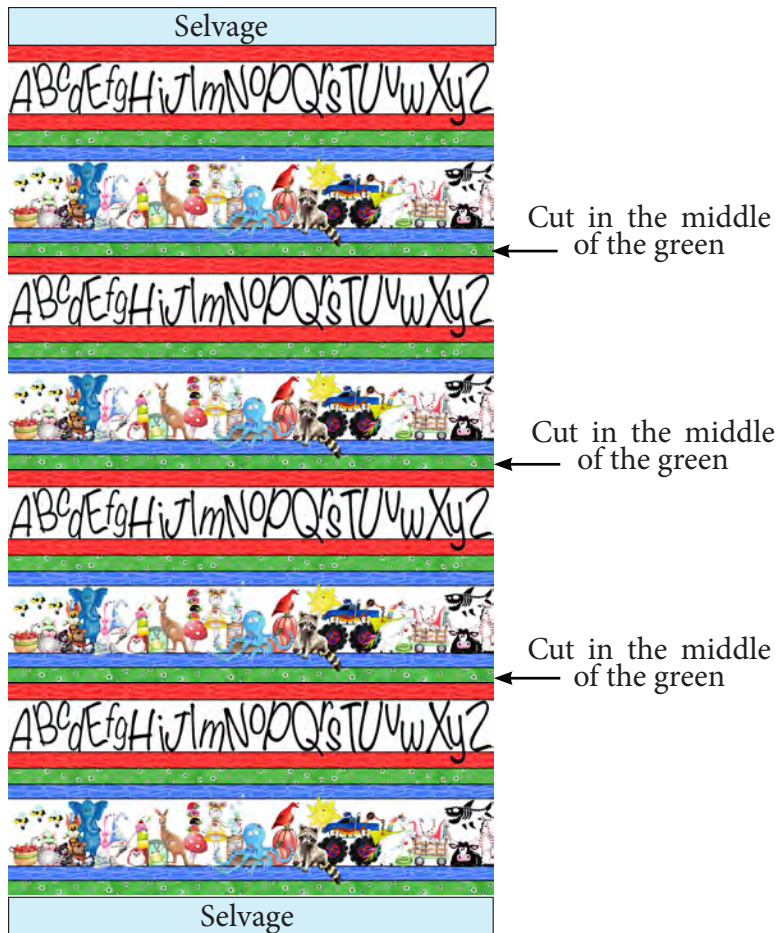
