### **CUTTING**

**1.** Fussy cut fabric **A**, using the Triangle template, place the template over the bird motifs and trace (10) triangles in the orientation shown. Triangles can be placed over different birds on the fabric. Cut out the triangles.




### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

- 2. Sew (1) C Triangle to (1) A Triangle. Sew (1) D Triangle to (1) E Triangle.
- **3.** Sew triangle pairs together matching seams to make a dark block. Blocks should measure 8-1/2" square including seam allowance. Make 5. Orientation of fabric **A** will change in (1) block.







**4.** Following steps 2-3, make (9) additional dark blocks from Triangles using the fabrics shown. Make the number indicated. Orientation of **A** triangles will differ in each of the (4) blocks.



**5.** Make the indicated number of each light block variation using **L, J, M** and **G** Triangles.





**6.** Sew (1) **J** Triangle to (1) **L** Triangle to make a triangle unit. Make 6. Sew (1) **M** triangle to (1) **G** Triangle to make a triangle unit. Make 6.

### QUILT CENTER

- **7.** Following the Quilt Layout, arrange the dark blocks alternating with the pastel blocks in diagonal rows noting the orientation of the blocks. Place the triangle units and (4) **J** Triangles along the sides, top and bottom edges to make a square. Arrange **O** 1" x 8-1/2"strips and **K** 1" squares between the blocks, triangle units and Triangles.
- **8.** Sew the blocks, triangle units and triangles together alternating with the **O** strips to make the block/ triangle rows.
- **9.** Sew the **O** 1"  $\times$  8-1/2" strips and **K** 1" squares together to make the sashing rows. Sew (1) **K** triangle to the end of each sashing row noting the orientation of the triangles.
- **10.** Sew the block/triangle rows and the sashing rows together matching the seams.

### **BORDERS**

**11. BORDER 1:** Measure the length of the quilt center. Cut (2) **K** 1-1/2" borders to this measurement. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Measure the width of the quilt. Cut (2) **K** 1-1/2" borders to this measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

**12. BORDER 2:** Measure the length of the quilt. Cut (2) **A** 4" borders to this measurement. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Measure the width of the quilt. Cut (2) **A** 4" borders to this measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

# **QUILT LAYOUT**

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using  $\bf N$  2-1/4" strips.
