In this class, you'll master how to create a sturdy box bottom, add neat finishing touches, and tie it all together with sweet fabric bows. It's the perfect project for gift giving—or keeping for yourself! **Finished Size: 14in x 14in x 8in.**



Learn to:

- How to cut and prepare fabric and interfacing for bag construction
- How to sew a **structured box bottom** for shape and stability
- How to create and attach **fabric bows** for decorative flair
- How to install **handles or straps** securely
- How to follow a **bag pattern** from start to finish with confidence

Basic Sewing Supplies as noted on reverse

Walking Foot for your specific machine

Pattern: [Box Bottom & Bows Bag Pattern](#)

Charm Pack or 30 assorted 5" squares

Matching thread for Top Stitching. This thread will show on the outside

[36" x 58" Soft and Stable](#)

1 ½ yards coordinating fabric (bag bottom, lining, handles, ties)

1/4 yard fusible fleece (handles)

Basting Spray or Safety pins for quilting

Class prep:

Pre-cut fabric as noted below (same as on pattern.)

5" Assorted Squares or Fabric:

If not using a charm pack, cut 30 - 5" squares.

Coordinating Fabric:

Cut (2) 5"x23" strips for the bag bottoms.

Cut (2) 5" WOF strips; sub-cut (4) 5"x20" pieces for bows.

Cut (1) 4" x WOF strip; sub-cut (2) 4"x20" strips

Reserve remaining fabric for lining (should have enough for two 22"x18" pieces)

Fusible Fleece:

Cut (2) 3"x20" strips for handles.

Soft and Stable:

Cut (2) 20"x25" pieces.

Bring your Basic Sewing Supplies to every class:

Sewing machine w/ electric cord & foot pedal
Sewing machine manual
Sewing machine needles
Spare empty bobbins
Rotary Cutter (45mm is great)
Thread
Snips
Seam Ripper
Small ruler (at least 6" x 12")
Heat Resistant straight pins (longer is better)
Flower Head straight pins (heat resistant is best)
Fabric marking pen or pencil, permanent and disappearing
Post-it notes/note pad & pen/pencil
Clover clips
