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
## HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on (1) **I** 8" square. Place **I** square, right sides together, on (1) **J** 8" square. Sew 1/4" away from right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) **I/J** HST blocks. Square to 7-1/2". Make (7) **I/J** squares, with one left over.
2. Using the Step 3 HST block assembly make the following blocks:



## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

3. Noting rotation of HST blocks, assemble Rows 1-7 as shown in diagram below. Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt top.



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **D** 2-1/4" strips.
