You've made your first quilt top and you've also learned how to make Half-Square Triangles (HSTs). Now you're ready to tackle a new block technique -- Flying Geese!

Learn to:

Make 4 Flying Geese at a time and trim them to the perfect measurements. Use the Wing Clipper 1 ruler by Deb Tucker Studios to maintain perfect 1/4" seam allowance for piecing

Joining Flying Geese units and maintaining triangle tips.



Supply List:

Basic Sewing Supplies noted below Small iron & pressing mat Red Geese pattern by Zen Chic, available in our store Magic Wand by Deb Tucker Studio, available in our store Wing Clipper I by Deb Tucker Studio, available in our store Fabric supplies as noted on pattern

Class prep:

Cut colored fabric into 18 - 10" x 10" squares (if you are using a layer cake you can skip this step). From background fabric, cut 28 - 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" squares and 72 –5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares. See pattern, pg 2 for cutting diagram
