Learn to:

Make a quilt that quilts as you go, includes sashing and a binding all at the same time! No need to send this to the Quilter when you're done!

Supply List:

<u>Zip Strip Pattern</u> with fabric yardage & batting required to make desired size quilt Batting Buddy

Mini iron and ironing board to work at your table

Matching thread for top stitching. You WILL see this thread on the sashing, borders & binding Straight pins

Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot

Rotary Cutter with new blade

6" x 12" Ruler

Basic Sewing Supplies noted below


Class prep:

Fabric A thru E and batting: Precut and label all fabric & batting as noted in CUTTING DIRECTIONS of pattern.

Use the Batting Buddy <u>LARGER</u> square ruler to cut the 9½" squares for the backing. (Use with the smaller square ruler inserted for safety.)

Use the Batting Buddy <u>SMALLER</u> square ruler to cut batting squares.
