

Collage Class—Hip Hop Bunny

This is an artistic fiber class for sewers and non-sewers alike! Work on the Hip Hop Collage pattern or another pattern of your choosing. We strongly suggest NOT to work on a pattern over 40". These patterns are very large and not able to be completed in two classes. Hip Hop finishes at 21" x 31 1/2"

Learn to:

Prepare the collage base for the artwork
Prepare the fabrics & florals for the collage
Learn about collage and how to build the design
How to finish the collage and apply it to the background
Discern color use to create interest and distinction
How to finish the art quilt.

Supply List:



Watch the "Prep" video. Scan the QR code to go to the video

For the first class please bring the following items. We will discuss the supplies needed for the 2nd class.

Fabric! You will need small pieces of fabric with LARGE motifs, LARGE leaves, flowers, ornaments & other motifs. Please see the sample fabrics I used in the video. I used flowers from charm squares, layer cakes and scraps. Don't worry to get whole flowers. Half a flower works just as well as a whole flower. Look for other fun motifs like presents, birds, hearts, candy, toys, and such. Look for motifs in different sizes and styles. Background Fabric - We'll talk about this in the 2nd class prior to your selection.
Do not bring your sewing machine. We will not be sewing at all.

There are two methods to creating your collage. Using **Pattern Ease** as the base of your collage or using an **Applique Mat** as your base. If you use Pattern Ease, you will need to purchase the Fabric Fuse Glue. If you use the Appli-Mat, you do not need to purchase the glue. Both methods work equally well and the final outcome will be the same. The Pattern Ease method is the older method in the pattern design and the Appli-Fuse Mat is the updated version in the newer patterns.

*1-1/8 yd Pattern Ease with the pattern traced onto it prior to class and Fabric Fuse Glue

or

Appli-Fuse Mat and NO GLUE

*Prepared florals and motifs as demonstrated in video

Extra fabrics as selected.

5 yds *Lite Steam a Seam 2. This is the only one to use, please don't substitute.

Karen K Buckley Scissors

10-12 Ziploc Bags, quart size to store all your cut-outs

Note pad w/pencil or pen for note taking

Prepurchase Hip Hop pattern by Laura Heine (or other pattern of your choosing)

Prepurchase fabric and supplies and start preparing your florals or motifs as explained in the video

If using Pattern Ease, trace the pattern outline onto the Pattern Ease with a pencil (Pattern Ease is the very thin interfacing type fabric.) You purchased about a 1-1/8 yd and it's see through)

If using the Appli-Mat, there is no tracing required. Just bring the mat and your supplies.

Cancellation Policy
