
Jelly Roll Rug Class

Just like you remember the rugs from your grandma's house, these rugs are wrapped and sewn using a Jelly Roll and your super power sewing skills! These classes are a 2 session class lasting 3-4 hrs each and homework in between sessions.

Class prep:

Sew all the jellyroll strips together end-to-end with a diagonal seam. This will make one long strip that is 2 1/2" wide.

All supplies are available in our store with a class discount.

Jelly Roll Pattern

Jelly Roll - 42 strips of 2.5" by WOF

Katahdin Batting - 2 1/4" x 50 yds

Large fabric clips

LG spool of thread at least 1200yds. Consider variegated thread, it's so pretty!

Mary Ellen's Best Press

Sewing Machine that can sew an adjustable zig-zag stitch

Clover Tube Maker

Walking Foot -MUST HAVE, VERY IMPORTANT!! Make sure it has the zig-zag opening for the needle to work.

A large sewing table attachment is highly recommended. It makes the construction of the rug much easier to manage.

*** we can order a sewing table for you. It takes 14-21 days to arrive***
