Learn to:

Use your sewing machine's applique stitch, set the correct width & length
Sew around corners, points and rounded edges
Copy and prepare the design for applique
Placement and layering of design

Supply List:

Basic Sewing Supplies (noted on back)

1/4" sewing foot

Applique foot or foot that has opening for zig-zag stitch

Small iron & ironing mat (optional but highly recommended)

Karen K Buckley Perfect Scissors - 6"

By Annie's Stiletto tool

Kim Schaefer's Calendar Quilts Pattern

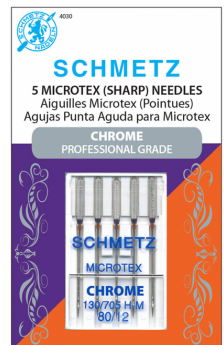
Fabric requirements as noted on pattern selected

Lite Steam a Seam 2, amount determined by the pattern you select and listed as "paper backed fusible web"

Sewing Machine manual (if possible)

Thread in various colors (optional)

80/12 Schmetz Microtext Chrome Finish needles 4030 (optional, but highly recommended. See Image →)



Class Homework:

Sew background **prior to class** as follows:

- Choose what pattern you would like to make from the pattern book. Purchase fabric as noted on selected pattern.
- Piece the Background (center):
 - Cut 15 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares for pieced background.
 - Sew 3 squares x 5 squares as shown on selected pattern (and page 3 of pattern).
 - Optionally, use 12.5" x 20.5" whole cloth instead of pieced background center.
- Piece the Border:
 - Cut 20 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares for pieced border. (July calls for STRIPS. Please check pattern and sew 20 strip blocks to use as 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.)
 - Sew together 4 rows of 5 squares (resulting in 4 rows that are 4 1/2" x 20 1/2").
- Attach Border to Background (center) - see page 3 of pattern:
 - Sew 2 of the borders to the sides of the Background. Press toward the borders.
 - Sew the top and bottom borders to the background. Press toward the borders.

Bring your Basic Sewing Supplies to every class:

Sewing machine w/ electric cord & foot pedal
Sewing machine manual
Sewing machine needles
Spare empty bobbins
Rotary Cutter(45mmisgreat)
Thread
Snips
Seam Ripper
Small ruler (at least 6" x 12")
Heat Resistant straight pins (longer is better)
Flower Head straight pins (heat resistant is best)
Fabric marking pen or pencil, permanent and disappearing
Post-it notes/note pad & pen/pencil
Clover clips
