1/2 yd assorted yellow (inner petals, Fabric 1)

1/4 yd assorted yellow (outer petals, Fabric 2)

(3) 1/8 yd cuts assorted purple fabrics

(3) 1/8 yd cuts assorted green fabrics

(8) 1/4 yd cuts assorted blue background fabrics

### Class prep:

Precut all fabric as directed on **page 1** of pattern (and on the back of this page). LABEL and bag each section (color) as noted on pattern.

- In the case that you are unable to attend the class, you must cancel at least 5 days prior to class date for a **FULL refund\*** in store credit.
- If you cancel 4 days prior to class, there is a **50% forfeiture fee** deducted from your class fee. *You may choose to transfer to another class if available, with a \$20 transfer fee plus additional registration fee if applicable.*

## Bring your Basic Sewing Supplies to every class:

Sewing machine w/ electric cord & foot pedal  
Sewing machine manual  
Sewing machine needles  
Spare empty bobbins  
Rotary Cutter (45mm is great)  
Thread  
Snips  
Seam Ripper  
Small ruler (at least 6" x 12")  
Heat Resistant straight pins (longer is better)  
Flower Head straight pins (heat resistant is best)  
Fabric marking pen or pencil, permanent and disappearing

## GENERAL CUTTING

### From yellow-1 fabric cut:

- (1) 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x wof, from strip cut -
  - (2) 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (then cut in half diagonally)
  - (4) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ "

- (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof, from strip cut -
  - (8) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ "

- (1) 4" x wof, from strip cut -
  - (8) 4" x 4"

### From yellow-2 fabric cut:

- (1) 5" x wof, from strip cut -
  - (8) 5" x 5"

### From purple-1 fabric cut:

- (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof, from strip cut -
  - (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
  - (1) 4" x 4"

### From purple-2 & purple-3 fabric cut:

- (8) 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ "

### From green-1 fabric cut:

- (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5"

### From green-2 fabric cut:

- (4) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5"

### From green-3 fabric cut:

- (4) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5"
- (1) 1" x 14  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (stem)

### From *EACH* assorted background fabric cut:

- (1) 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x wof, from strip cut -
  - (1) 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (cut in half diagonally-keep 12 triangles total, discard 4)
  - (1) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" (8 total)
  - (2) 4" x 4" (keep 14 total, discard 2)
  - (5) 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" (keep 36, discard 4)
- (1) 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof, cut one of the following from assorted background strips for the border pieces
  - (2) 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 23  $\frac{1}{4}$ "
  - (4) 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{4}$ "
  - (2) 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12  $\frac{3}{4}$ "
