Spellbound Witch Hat Class

Get ready to add some handmade magic to your Halloween! In this class, you'll learn how to sew the Spellbound Hat by Polka Dot Chair. Whether you're making it as part of a costume, as festive décor, or just for a touch of witchy whimsy, this project is fun, creative, and perfect for the season.

The finished hat is approximately 16" tall by 20" wide. The interior circle has a 22-23" inch circumference. It fits "most" adults and includes instructions to slightly size the hat for a smaller circumference head. This hat is not intended for children.

You will have the option to make either a "quilted fabric" or "quilted patchwork fabric" version.

Learn how to:

- · Sew with stabilizer and interfacing
- Create and shape a 3D project (not just flat sewing)
- Follow a commercial sewing pattern step by step
- Create edge finishing for a polished look
- · Attach and sew curved seams
- · Add lining for structure and a neat interior

Basic Sewing Supplies noted on back

Spellbound Witch Hat Pattern by Polka Dot Chair 1 Fat Quarter or 1/2 yard fabric for Sash (or 2 yards 1 1/2" wide wired ribbon) Soft & Stable 18" x 53" 3/4 Yard Craft Fuse P808



Quilted Fabric Version:

- 3/4 Yard Fabric or 1 1/4 yards fabric if you are using a directional print* for hat top and hat brim.
- 3/4 Yards for hat lining
- One additional Fat Quarter or 1/2 yard fabric for the bias binding on the brim edge
- One additional Fat Quarter or 1/2 yard fabric for bias binding on the center of the brim. .

* if you create your hat with directional fabric, you need additional yardage if your print does not run parallel to the selvedge edge



Quilted Patchwork Fabric Version:

- For hat top: 3/4 yard TOTAL fabric in various prints cut into 2 1/2" wide strips. You need at least TEN strips of fabric 2 1/2" x WOF.
- For hat brim: 3/4 yard Fabric
- 3/4 Yards Fabric for **hat lining**. The underside of the brim will not be patchwork.
- One additional Fat Quarter or 1/2 yard fabric for the bias binding on the **brim edge**.
- One additional Fat Quarter or 1/2 yard fabric for bias binding on the center of the brim.

Class prep:

- Cut and Sew bias binding strips: 60" of brim fabric and 26" of brim lining fabric.
- Quilt fabric before class instructions on page 4 of the pattern.
- If you are making the *Quilted Patchwork Hat* option, please have all piecing finished so that you have two patchwork pieces that are 19" x 19" and 16" x 16". These will need to be quilted as instructed on page 4 of the pattern.

Bring your Basic Sewing Supplies to every class:

Sewing machine w/ electric cord & foot pedal
Sewing machine manual
Sewing machine needles
Spare empty bobbins
Rotary Cutter (45mm is great)
Thread
Snips
Seam Ripper
Small ruler (at least 6" x 12")
Heat Resistant straight pins (longer is better)
Flower Head straight pins (heat resistant is best)
Fabric marking pen or pencil, permanent and disappearing
Post-it notes/note pad & pen/pencil
Clover clips



Directions for Quilted Patchwork Fabric Version:


1. Sew 10 (or more) strips of your 2.5" x WOF fabric together as shown. Cut into 16 strips.




2. Sew the units together, alternating directions, as shown. The resulting patchwork should measure close to 20 ½" x 32 ½"


3. Cut your patchwork into two pieces:

The 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square will be used for the hat brim.

5. Re-attach the bottom two rows to the right side of the other block.

This block should roughly measure 16 ½" x 18 ½" with a missing corner.

This will be used for the hat top.
